

Did you know?...

The world records for human-powered speed are

- 82 mph Top Speed
- 54 mph average speed for One-Hour.

These marks were set by streamlined recumbent bicycles on flat ground, with no drafting, no tailwind.

Come be a witness to history this summer **July 17, 18, 19** at the **Ford Human Powered Speed Challenge** sponsored by the International Human Powered Speed Association (IHPVA) and the Michigan Human Powered Speed Association (MHPVA) and World Recumbent Racing Association (WRRA). Ultra Marathon Cycling (UMC) rules may also sanction distance events to recognize records. Some of the fastest streamlined recumbents in the world will attempt to better the world records on the five mile oval of the Ford Michigan Proving Grounds.



Challenge events include:

- One-Hour Time Trial
- 100 km / 100 mile Century
- Six-Hour Time Trial
- 200-meter Top Speed
- Kilometer Standing Start
- 1/4 Mile Drag Races
- Tricycle Race
- Hill Coast-Down Event
