

## **1000m TT standing start record attempt by Anneke Korthout**

On the 8th of Februari 2007 Anneke Korthout (female, born 18-6-1970, Netherlands) made an attempt to improve the existing record over 1000 m TT standing start for tailfaired recumbent vehicles.

### ***Location***

The run took place at the Sportpaleis-Alkmaar velodrome in Alkmaar, the Netherlands. The altitude is appr. at sea level. The track is an indoor wooden oval with a length of 250 m with banked curves. At the inside of the track is the blue band, 20 cm from the blue band is the 5 cm wide black measurement line, 90 cm above the inside of the track the 5 cm wide red sprinter's line, further to the outside of the track is the blue stayers line.

### ***Weather conditions***

The temperature was about 20 degree Celsius. As the track is indoor there was no wind.

### ***Vehicle***

Anneke rode a tailfaired M5 Lowracer recumbent.

### ***1000 m TT***

The 1000m TT started at 14:07. Anneke completed her four laps in 1:25.58.

### ***Timing equipment and calculation***

The times were kept with the ChipX transponder timing system manufactured by AMB. The timing started automatically with the first passing of the bike through a light switch. Before the start the starter placed the bike so that it just didn't trip the lights witch.

Technical specifications ChipX timing system:

Decoder timing resolution: 0,001 sec

Decoder clock stability: 0,5 ppm
